



Armamentarium for Atraumatic Extraction and Ridge Preservation

Prichard retractor ("Beaver Tail")

Suture Needle Holder (Laschal Thumb Lock is my preferred)

Straight Luxators 2mm and 3mm blade width (Directa is my preferred brand)

Periodontal bone files = 'Curette' = Orban 10/11 and Orban 11/12

Traditional #11 Miller Curette

Molt 2 Elevator with Bulkier Handle for Root Tips

Tissue pick-up

University of Minnesota Retractor

Molt 2/4 elevator for flap elevation

Regular Periosteal elevator (Molt #9) for flap elevation

Standard surgical blade handle (#3 Handle)

15c blades

Surgical Suction Tip

Traditional Mouth Mirror

Traditional Injection Syringe

Traditional intraoral Scissors for cutting suture

Bite Block

Surgical Handpiece (no air) and 701 or 702 bur

Grafting Material:

- Amnon Chorion Membrane (10x10 = Single tooth site or 15 x 20 = Buccal Wall defect)
- Min/Demin Cortical Allograft particle size 0.25-1.0mm (0.5cc = anterior/premolar, 1cc=molar)
- 15 x 20 - Resorbable Collagen Membrane or 12 x 24 PTFE membrane = other options

Sutures

Reverse Cutting, C6 Needle is most common; 18 or 27 inch length

- Resorbable = 3.0 Chromic Suture
- Long term resorbable (4-6 weeks) = 4.0 PGCL monofilament
- Non-resorbable = 4.0 PTFE
